At the time of writing this message there is no price ceiling on seeds. The prices listed in this book are based on the seed stocks we now have on hand. When our present stocks are exhausted, it may be necessary to adjust our prices; therefore, all seeds are offered subject to prior sale and to change in prices without further notice.

It is our hope to supply you with all the seeds you need and we urge that you order as soon as possible.

Terms of Payment

Effective January 1, 1943, all invoices for purchases will be charged at the prices quoted in this Burpee Blue List, unless Special Offers are made by letter or telegram and referred to when the order is placed.

Our terms are cash with order unless you have an account with us or are satisfactorily rated by the commercial agencies. To those who have accounts and others of approved credit, our terms are 60 days net; 2% discount for cash in ten days from date of invoice, or 3% discount when cash accompanies the order, for Vegetable and Flower Seeds and Flower Bulbs. No discount on Grass Seeds, Clover Seeds, Onion Sets, Potatoes, Roots, and Supplies, or on shipping charges, all of which are net cash.

New customers, unless satisfactorily rated with the commercial agencies, should furnish us with at least three trade references. Orders from new customers amounting to less than \$5.00 should be accompanied by cash.

Orders for seeds will be shipped C.O.D. upon receipt of a deposit of 25% of the value of the order.

We guarantee the vitality and purity of Burpee's Seeds and Bulbs to the full amount of the purchase price. You can have your money back any time within a year if you are not satisfied with the results. Even with the highest quality seeds and bulbs, success in gardening depends largely upon cultivation, soil, and weather conditions. Therefore, in no case shall W. Atlee Burpee Co. be liable for more than the amount actually paid us for seeds or bulbs. All goods are sold under this guarantee.

Free Delivery anywhere in the United States, except where stated otherwise

Flower Seeds, in any quantity, will be sent prepaid. All Vegetable Seeds offered "Transportation Prepaid" will be delivered postpaid or express paid, our option. On Beans, Sweet Corn, Pop Corn, Peas, Rape, Sunflower and Grass Seeds, Asparagus Roots, Garlic Sets, Horse Radish Roots, Mushroom Spawn, Onion Sets, Peanuts, Potatoes, and Rhubarb Roots offered "Not Prepaid," the purchaser pays the transportation charges. If such goods are wanted by Parcel Post, include sufficient to cover postage on cash orders. On charge orders, postage will be invoiced.

If flower bulbs or roots are wanted, we will allow you a 25% discount from the retail prices of separate varieties; 20% discount on special bulb collection offers. Customer pays transportation charges. No discount will be allowed on bulbs or roots if the retail value of goods ordered at one time is less than \$2.00.

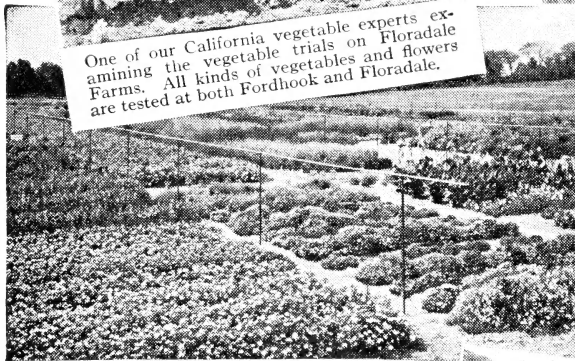
FORDHOOK FARMS PENNSYLVANIA ★ FLORADALE FARMS, CALIFORNIA

One of our California vegetable experts examining the vegetable trials on Floradale Farms. All kinds of vegetables and flowers are tested at both Fordhook and Floradale.

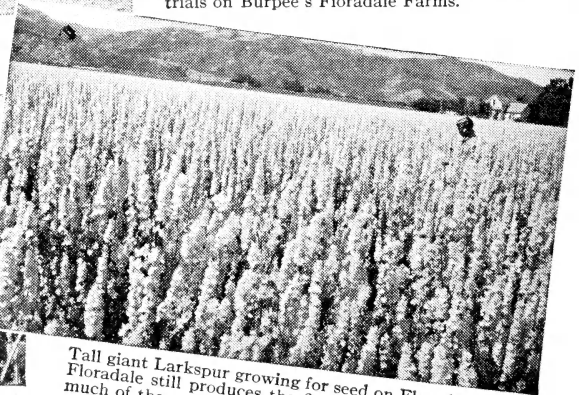


Our vegetable experts, Condit and Pride, are carefully examining and making notes of the table beet trials on Burpee's Floradale Farms.

Many years ago we started in to train women to raise vegetable seeds on Floradale. They have become very proficient; this picture shows them harvesting leek seed.



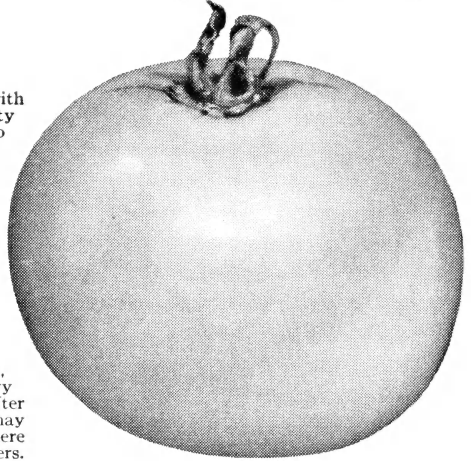
Tall giant Larkspur growing for seed on Floradale Farms. Floradale still produces the finest flower seeds, although much of the acreage is now devoted to vegetables.

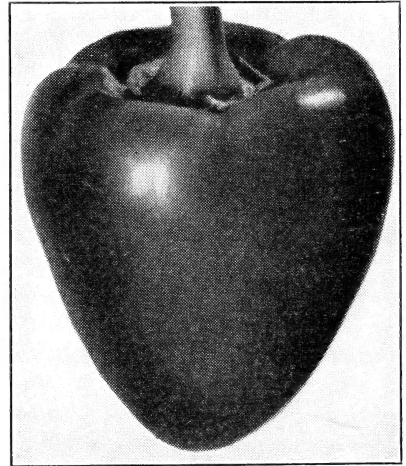

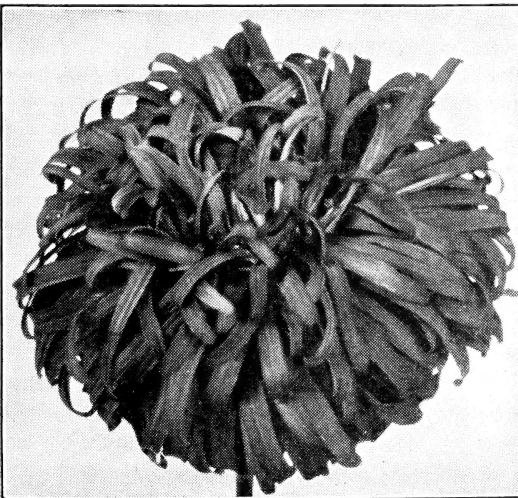

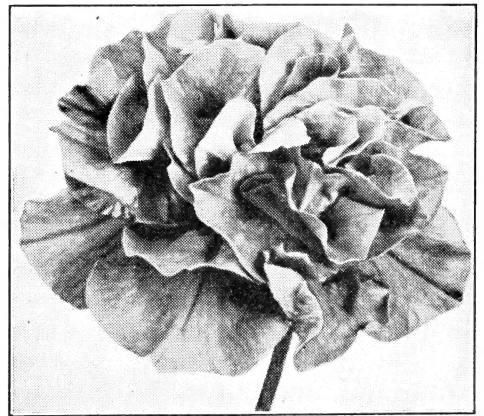

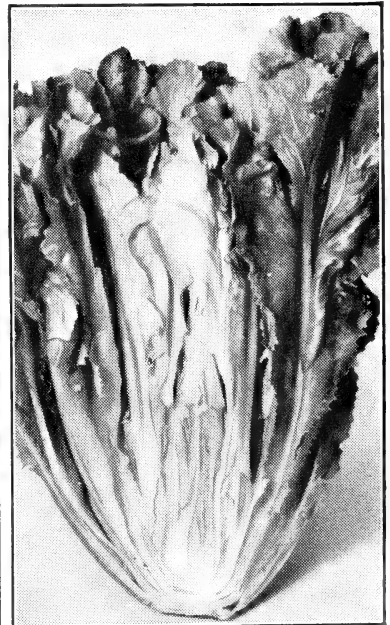
