

REUTER'S CREOLE EASTER LILIES

The Creole (Louisiana Grown) Easter Lilies have proven their superiority as forcing lilies. They are more vigorous and stronger growers than the Japanese; the stout stems need no staking and the foliage is a healthy and intense dark green color. The flowers are of colossal size, a glistening, pure white color, and of heavy texture, making them especially well fitted for shipping.

Start bulbs at 50 to 55 degrees. When root system is well developed, move pots on top of benches and raise temperature to 60 to 65 degrees.


