The bulbs are guaranteed free from thrip, as we treat our bulbs in storage. We advise everyone to treat their bulbs with Lysol. Directions will be packed with your order if requested.

ORDER CHANGES

It sometimes happens that we are out of the size you order, but have other sizes in the same variety. Please state if you wish us to send another size or variety if out of what you order. You will always receive liberal value for any change.

SHIPMENT

A service charge of 35 cents will be made on orders of less than \$3.00.

Orders for \$15.00 or more can be sent at any time in the U. S. A. by express and those held for spring delivery will be shipped as weather permits. Local and Pacific Coast orders can be sent at any time.

We advise Railway Express shipment as wartime conditions cause long delays if sent via freight.

All stock offered and orders accepted F. O. B. Portland, Oregon, subject to prior sale and causes beyond our control.
