## These Are LILAC ARISTOCRATS

## $\$$

As hardy and as free from disease as the oldfashioned common lilac and vastly more beautiful. These French varieties bloom freely when young plants, bearing huge spikes with large single or double florets. The color ranges thru the pinks to I) ubonnet red, and thru the lavenders to deep purple. They do not sucker as freely as the common lilac. All are pleasingly fragrant.

Strong bushes which have flowered.
Individually grown.
On own-roots.
Dug fresh to your order.

Alphonse LaValle. Double. Deep blue-purple buds open to form a double fringed floret of delicate periwinkle blue. Clusters large, shapely and compact. Bush vigorous.

Belle de Nancy. Double. Rose-pink buds opening a lighter shade. One of the most beautiful lilacs.

Glorie de Moulins. Single. Dark red, very free flowering, a mass of bloom which completely covers the bush. Very desirable.

Marie leGrey. Single. Very large white florets in clusters of medium size. Strong, erect, profuse bloomer. Early. First choice in a collection.

Mme. Lemoine. Double. Pure white with large narrow clusters. Very satisfactory and popular. Dependable bloomer. Midseason.
