CAMELLIA SASANQUA

One of the newer and finest of all the broad-leaved evergreen. Similar to *Camellia Japonica*, but looser and faster growing. Very profuse bloomers, the flowers commencing to open the latter part of September and continuing on through November.

Sasanquas are very hardy and can be grown without protection. These plants are shipped semi-bare-rooted.

CLEOPATRA — Semi-double rose color flowers. Foliage dark and glossy. Vigorous and compact grower.

SNOW ON THE MOUNTAIN — Large double white flowers. Profuse bloomers.

PINK TEXAS STAR—Semi-double, shell pink. Tall slender grower like Lombardy poplar.

ONE LOT UNNAMED SASANQUAS — Single flowers, colors range from white through apple blossom to deep pink. No choice of colors.

CAMELLIA JAPONICA

These camellias have been grown all summer in quart cans and are strong bushy plants. Size 8 to 10 inches.

ALBA PLENA—Snow white double flower. Oldest but still most popular white. Early bloomer.

DAIKAGURA—Probably earliest bloomer, nearly always in bloom in September. Flowers large thick peony type, deep rose color variegated.

SNOW—Purest white double flower, up right grower.

SWEET BRIER—Pink single flower Good landscape plant, up-right grower.
