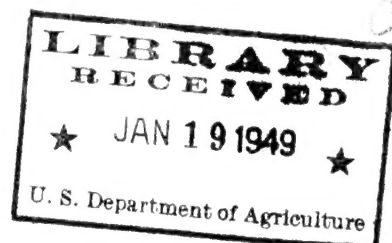

WHOLESALE LIST - CACTI AND SUCCULENTS

The following assortments are especially recommended to those who wish to leave the selection of the best material available to us. None of the following assortments will be labelled unless specially requested.

50 Variety Special - 100 plants \$6.00. Includes 2 plants of 50 varieties of our better cactus and succulents.

BOWL MAKERS SPECIAL ASSORTMENT - 100 plants \$4.00. Includes many varieties of cactus and succulents selected for form and color from our complete stock.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 1 - 100 plants \$4.00. Includes Corous, Echinopsis, Eriocorou, Monvilleas and Opuntias or similar varieties, in 2 1/2" pot size or suitable for dish gardens, varied as stock is available.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 2 - 100 plants \$5.00. Contains rare collectors items in a fine colorful selection of unusual Mexican and South American species (principally seedlings) suitable for small pots and the better dish gardens.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 3 - 100 plants \$7.50. Contains larger plants of our selection, such as offered in Assortment No. 2 but are considerably larger in size suitable for small pots and the better dish gardens. This assortment is in great demand by those who have collector trade.

SUCCULENT ASSORTMENT NO. 4 - 100 plants \$3.00. Consists of 10 or more kinds of the more popular dish garden varieties such as Aconium, Bryophyllum, Grassula, Echeveria, Sedum, Sempervivum and others as stock becomes available.
