

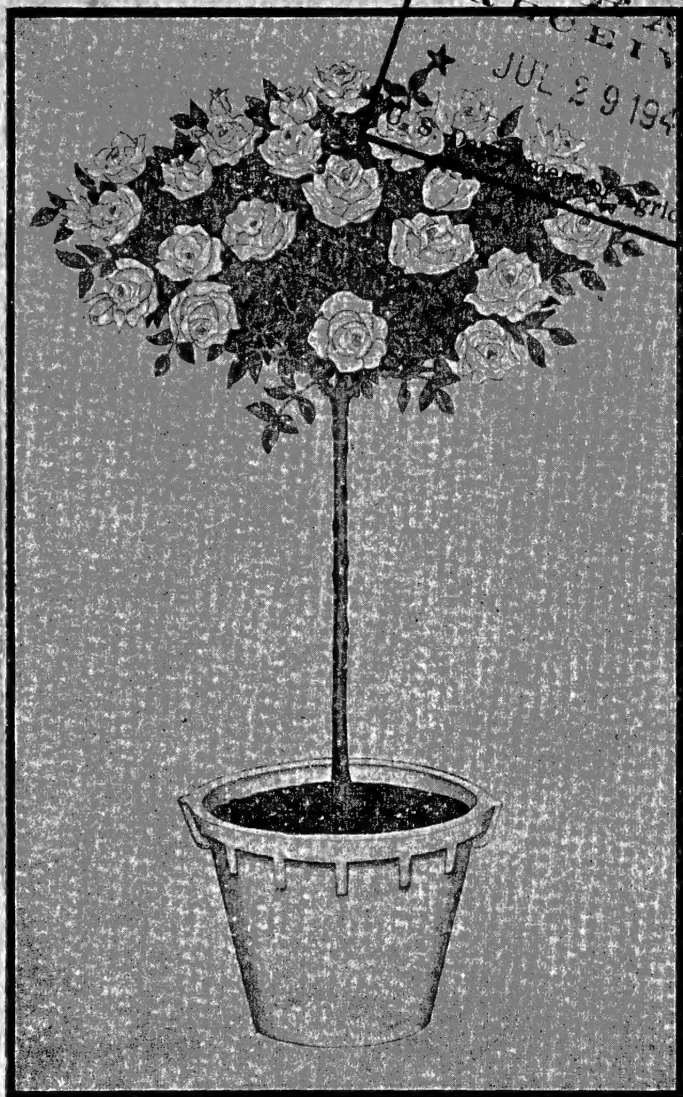

Red Shades

PATENTED

APPLAUSE—Pat. 942

Won 1947 Bagatelle Gold Medal. Is a brilliant light red in color with yellow base on each petal when opened. Flowers are often 5 inches across, and are pleasantly fragrant. Performs exceedingly well in all climates. Is free-branching and mildew resistant. Our choice in this color as a tree.

CALIFORNIA CENTENNIAL—P.a.f.

An H. S. introduction for 1949. Vigorous, upright, dark green leaves, long pointed buds, large petaled flowers of a glowing rich crimson. Does not blue. Exceptional.

CHARLOTTE ARMSTRONG—Pat. 455 (AARS)

Carmine red buds open to magnificent blooms of vivid cerise. Long stemmed vigorous grower. Still ranks tops.

*FANDANGO—P.a.f.

Of all the roses we grow this one comes into bloom earliest in spring. A big, vigorous, glossy foliaged plant, the color is a rich deep scarlet in bud, which opens to a bright cerise red flower. The petals have a ruffled crisp appearance which adds to its beauty. Mildly fragrant. Similar, but darker than Guillot. An Armstrong introduction last season.

GRAND DUCHESS CHARLOTTE—P.P.P. (AARS)

Rich claret color, changes to rose as it opens. Big, strong, free branching plant, lovely fragrance.

HEART'S DESIRE—Pat. 501 (AARS)

Beautiful red with long unfurling petals; deep red heart and exquisite fragrance. Vigorous grower. A "must have" every year.

MIRANDY—Pat. 632 (AARS)

Gorgeous, Armstrong creation, won All-American Award for 1945. Big buds are rich red with black shadings. Most extraordinary feature is marvelously delicious damask fragrance.

NOCTURNE—Pat. 713 (AARS)

Color is bright cardinal-red with dark shadings. Stems are long, foliage luxuriant, sturdy grower. By Armstrong.

SAN FERNANDO—P.a.f. (AARS)

A grand new red rose with lasting fragrance. Buds are long and pointed. Vigorous grower, disease resistant, long stemmed. Improved Heart's Desire.

TEXAS CENTENNIAL—Pat. 162

Sport of rose Pres. Hoover. Color brick-red turning to cerise-red with age. Free flowering and vigorous.

Deep red, intensely fragrant, of strong and vigorous growth. Free blooming and an ideal cut flower.

CHRISTOPHER STONE

This rose is very popular for its freedom of blooms and its beautiful color, having large heavy foliage.

ETOILE DE HOLLANDE

Velvety dark crimson, fragrant.

GYPSY LASS

Perfect shaped flowers of dark scarlet crimson. Vigorous bloomer.

HADLEY

Velvety rich crimson flowers, attractive long stems.

McGREDY'S SCARLET

Excellent formed flowers of variable scarlet, grows vigorously. Blooms freely.

NIGHT

The buds and flowers are well shaped and quite double and fragrant. Darkest of all reds.

POINSETTIA

Vigorous grower. Long buds. Parent of San Fernando.

RED HOOVER

Long spiral buds open to light clear canary yellow flowers of perfect proportions. Vigorous grower, long stemmed. Tops for form.

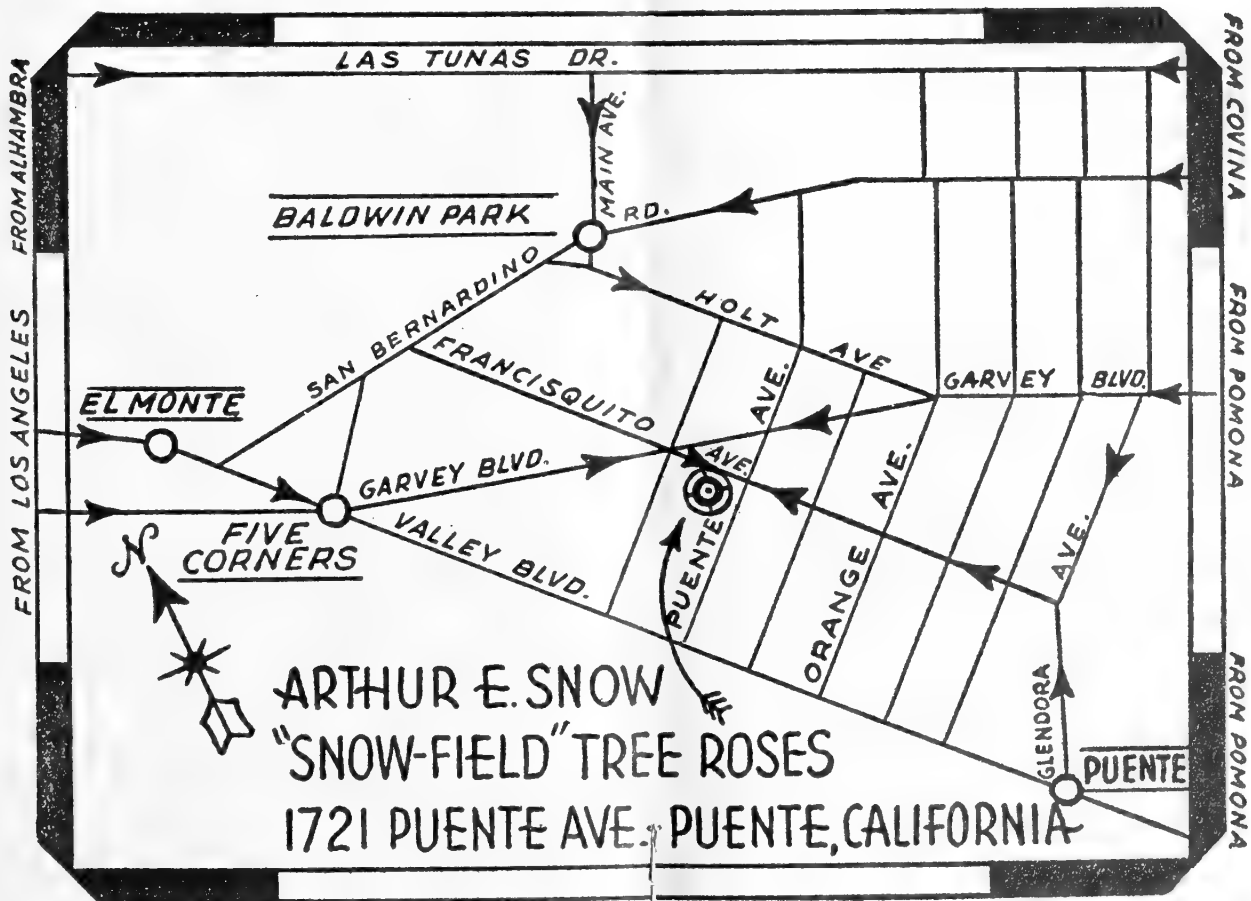
PEACE—Pat. 591 (AARS)

GOLDEN EMBLEM

Golden yellow with tinge of red on edges of petals.

(Vermillion and Yellow). A good grower, rich colors, fragrant, free bloomer.

CONTRAST

Silver with pink reverse. Vigorous grower, long stemmed.

TANGO

Cerise inside flower—straw yellow reverse.

*Singles and Semi-Doubles***DAINTY BESS (Pink)**

Distinctive rose pink, single.

LULU (Salmon Pink)

Long pointed buds, semi double flowers with beautiful foliage.

Polyanthas and Floribundas

CRIMSON ROSETTE—Pat. No. 967

Many clusters of crimson hybrid polyantha type flowers. Strong grower, makes large, well-shaped head as tree rose. Mildew-free foliage.

DENNY BOY (Multicolor)—P.P.P.

The best description of this Marsh rose is that it is like a miniature "Peace" rose in coloring. The tiny and dainty buds are delightful in bouquets. It is free-flowering.

FLORADORA (Cinnabar Red)

Gayest floribunda of them all. Very satisfactory, keeps well cut. Excellent tree.

PASADENA TOURNAMENT (Dark Red)—P.P.P.

This rose is a small compact to a medium size rose tree well covered with a good rich green foliage. From the small dainty buds literally bursts forth a pageant of regular sized velvety red flowers. Dainty in every way and almost completely thornless. Best of "Sweetheart Roses."

PINK ROSETTE—Pat. No. 970

Brilliant, dark glowing pink. Otherwise identical to Crimson Rosette. We recommend the pink and crimson varieties as tree roses.
