

Certified Buffalo Alfalfa is now in full harvest in California. Pressure of Kansas demand still has this market "in the air" but in due time it should quiet down.

<u>Certified Ranger Alfalfa</u> is yielding exceedingly well. We hear that there may be a 20 million pound crop of this variety. Sellers' and buyers' ideas are still apart.

Ladino Clover is now selling well for both spot and later positions. The new crop will not be as large as thought. Demand is heavy for non-certified, rather poor for certified.

Arizona Alfalfa has advanced. Demand is heavier than expected. Yields and acreages are way down for 1951 crop. This market is moving up. Same for California Alfalfa.
