#### CYPRIPEDIUM SEEDLINGS

Price of seedlings is based on length of leaves. Plants with leaves averaging 1-1/2 to 2 inches are priced at \$5.00; those with leaves 2 to 3 inches at \$7.00; those with leaves 4 to 5 inches at \$10.00; and those with leaves 6 inches and over at \$15.00 and \$20.00.
