Midseason Blooming Mums

All of the following are excellent varieties.

The abundance of flowers of the rich fall colors will provide baskets and vases of bouquets. Will you have bouquets next fall after frost has destroyed other garden flowers? Mums will continue to bloom and make a fine display. Only a freeze will destroy a Chrysanthemum bud not yet open and these buds will open after the early frosts and produce perfect flowers for cutting.

Late Blooming Mums

These late blooming varieties are some of most beautiful hardy chrysanthemums in existence. All are outstanding and very, very frost resistant. However they require full sunlight and will not bloom if planted in a shady location. Don't buy late blooming varieties if you have a shady place for your mum garden.
