## - Harrald's Pedigreed Strain PANSY PLANTS

We supply these in two grades. The large size which is normally about as large as once transplanted stock supplied by most growers. This size will be sent unless it is specified that the smaller stock suited for flat transplanting is desired. The large grade ranges from 20 to 30 pounds per 1,000 shipping weight while the flatting grade is from 12 to 20 pounds.

## ABOUT TRANSPORTATION

The price quoted by the hundred plants includes postage tol any point in the U. S. A. and orders for less than 250 plants of a variety will be charged for at the 100 price and be postpaid. Not less than 50 plants of a variety will be supplied at wholesale rates. A retail catalogue will be supplied if you want smaller quantities. Minimum plant order at wholesale will be $\$ 2.00$.

Orders for larger quantities may be sent Express collect in which case you would pay only the actual amount of the transportation charges on delivery. In this case you remit the net F. O. B. Grants Pass price as quoted by the 1,000 or more.

If you want large orders sent Parcel Post it will be necessary that you remit for the postage or that we make the postage charges C. O. D. In the event that you want the charges made C. O. D. we will make a service charge of $25 \phi$ per carton in addition to the actual postage and collection charges to reimburse us for the added clerical work on C. O. D. forms. If you wish to remit funds for the postage we will be glad to prepay charges and refund to you any overage above actual postage costs, making refund along with the invoice. In remitting funds to prepay postage without C. O. D. send at the rate of $\$ 5.00$ per 1,000 plants for large grade and $\$ 4.00$ per 1,000 on the smaller size. To most localities this will fully pay the charges with probably some refund. In some cases to points east of the Mississippi River we may have to bill a small balance for transportation which we will do in cases where the above amounts are remitted. You can then send the balance due.

We recommend Parcel Post as being the cheapest and just about as safe but you must select the method desired. If remittance for transport is not made and no instructions are given we will always ship large orders Express collect.

All offers are made with the understanding that we are responsible for delivery in good order only to the office of the transport agency at Grants Pass, Ore, and that thereafter the shipment is the property of the purchaser.

## QUANTITY PRICES

Units of not less than 250 plants of a variety may be combined to procure the 1,000 price. The 3,000 price will apply only to units of 1,000 plants or more of a variety where the order total is more than 3,000 in those sorts offered at the 3,000 rate. The 3,000 rate is available only where 3,000 or more is to be shipped at one time.
