

GIANT CAMELLIA FLOWERED DOUBLE

These are the largest flowered and by far the most popular of the entire group. The flowers look like huge Camellias, often more perfectly formed even than Camellias. This strain also developes some attractive types that resemble Peonies, roses and even water-lilies although these are sport types. Coloring, as with all Tuberous Begonias, is luscious shades of a clarity and value to be found in no other group of flowers. In the growing fields flowers as large as dinner plates are often produced and we've had customers report bloom of 10 inch and more diameter. Usually they are no smaller than 3 inches and when culture is suitable will average 4 to 6 inches across. If this is your first experience with Tuberous Begonias we highly recommend this type as your first venture. If you're experienced they will still be your best type for 75% of your planting.

COLORS AVAILABLE: Apricot, pink, orange, rose pink, red, rose, salmon, scarlet, yellow and white. Also available in mixture well blended.

GIANT CARNATION FLOWERED DOUBLE

Double frilled with petal edges lacinated, these give the appearance of huge Carnations. Easily the second most popular type. Not quite as large as the Camellia type they are still huge and the coloring is just as brilliant and attractive. All these flowers set off against the clean, brilliant foliage is a sight not soon forgotten.

COLORS AVAILABLE: Apricot, orange, pink, red, salmon, scarlet, yellow, white or all colors mixed.

CRISPA or SINGLE FRILLED

This strain is much improved over stock usually offered in this class - more heavily ruffled. The edge of the petals are heavily frilled somewhat after the fashion of giant ruffle Petunia, Super Fluffy Ruffled. Coloring of course is typically Begonia.

COLORS AVAILABLE: Apricot, orange, pink, red, rose, salmon, scarlet, yellow, white or all colors mixed.

HANGING BASKET or PENDULA

Of trailing habit this all-double strain makes ideal plants for hanging baskets, wirdow or porch boxes and where they can trail down a rockery bank. In fact a few plants in the shaded rockery will dress it up in an unusual manner all summer. While flowers produced by this type are not large they are produced literally by the hundred and the plant is a mass of color almost from the first open bloom. NOVELTY TYPES

This group will be found of interest because of its varied forms. However, it is recommended to the commercial grower only to meet the limited demand of his more experimentally inclined customers so quotations and supplies are in small units.

CRISTATA or CRESTED: A single frilled type having heavy tufts or ponpoms on the center of each flower petal. Very attractive. Flowers are quite large and available in mixed colors only. Many have two-tones.

MARMORATA: A medium flower of Camellia form mottled white on rose.

MARGINATA: Similar in type to Crispa but having a contrasting border around each flower petal. Two forms, either white with pink border or salmon with copper edge.

PICOTEE DOUBLE: A beautiful Camellia form of very large size. Differs from the Camellia regular in that the flowers are two-toned, usually in shades of pink and rose with darker edging of each flower petal. Mixture only.

BOSEBUD DOUBLE: A form resembling Hybrid Tea roses and a most popular pot plant. Many folks favor the delicate flower form of these. Medium large in size often to 6". Colors a well blended mixture only.

EXOTIC MIXTUBE: This mixture is from regular types and many hybrid seedlings from our breeding work. It contains literally hundreds of colors, shades and forms. PROPAGATING TUBERS

These are small tubers cultured from late sown seedlings. They are from ½ to 1 inch diameter. With reasonable culture they will produce larger plants more quickly and with less cultural exactness than when growing from seed. They make nice plants for spring and early summer sale from 3 or 4 inch pots and when bedded out usually give good bloom from August until frost. Available in limited quantity as follows.



The 100 price applies to 100 or more tubers of a size, not less than 10 tubers of a color or type. The plants are pleasingly compact but of robust growth usually from 8 to 10 inches high under good culture. Flower stems are 12 to 16 inches with flowers well above the foliage. The flower heads, composed of many florets which are often individually larger than a silver dollar, are often 8 inches or more across. Coloring is the most brilliant of any strain available in this type. While available in mixed colors only, the blend contains yellow, red, purple and white in the more common shades plus pink, flame and bronze shades in pastel and poly-chrome combinations that are rare. A few blue shades are in the mixture, Marking of the flowers is just as outstanding with selfs blotched and laced markings in the flowers.
