


We are very happy to present our 1952 Price List for your consideration. We wish to thank our old customers for the nice orders we have received in the past, also for the letters of commendation for our bulbs. We wish to assure you and prospective customers that we shall endeavor to merit your continued patronage.

Our 1951 season was a most satisfactory one, in spite of the fact that we did get somewhat more than our share of rain late in the season. We were very much pleased with the results from clearing and fitting an entirely new piece of land for our glads. Our glads were unusually thrifty and free from disease. We carefully rogued our plantings, harvested early, and dried our bulbs rapidly with circulating, artificial heat. After cleaning, all bulbs were dusted with Spergon and DDT. We intend to sell only good clean healthy bulbs. On receipt of your order from us, if you are not entirely satisfied with the bulbs, we would appreciate it if you would return them to us, and we will gladly refund your money. We cannot, however, be responsible for the results obtained. We do send cultural directions with every order, and we are very glad to help you with your problems.

As is our custom we have added several new varieties to our list and dropped some of the older ones. We cannot afford to try all of the new varieties, but we are sure that you will be pleased with those we are offering. It seems a pity that so many of the older varieties are being discarded in favor of newer and sometimes inferior ones. You will notice that we are still retaining some of the older ones. We believe that each variety that we are listing, whether old or new, has merit and is worthy of your consideration. Price and date of introduction are not necessarily the measure of quality.

Our terms are cash with orders up to \$5.00. On orders over \$5.00 we will accept 25% with order, balance before shipment. We will prepay transportation on orders of \$2.50 and up, except orders for collections and wholesale orders. On orders amounting to less than \$2.50, add 25ϕ extra for postage and packing.

On orders from \$3.00 to \$5.00 you may select 5% extra in bulbs of your own choosing. From \$5.00 to \$25.00 select 10%, and over \$25.00 select 20%. This discount does not apply to wholesale orders or collections. If you prefer to leave the selection of extras to us we will do our best to please you.

To avoid disappointment send your orders in as early as possible. Let us know if we may substitute a variety of equal value if we should be sold out of any variety. Bulbs will be shipped in April in plenty of time for planting, unless otherwise requested.

All bulbs in our list are large size (1 1/4 inches and up). All stock is certified by the State of Maine Department of Agriculture to be apparently free from injurious insects and diseases.
