We are located 300 miles north of Chicago, Ill., on the Chicago Milwaukee St. Paul & Pacific Ry., 295 miles east of St. Paul Minn., on the Soo Line Ry., in north eastern Wisconsin. Highways U.S. 8 and U. S. 141. Visitors are always welcome.

TERMS:

Cash before shipment unless otherwise arranged for.

All Prices are F. O. B. Pembine, Wis. and subject to change without Notice. Quotaions are for bare root stock packed in damp moss.

Orders will be booked subject to crop loss from any cause beyond our control, correctness of count, Etc. We will gladly correct any Errors made in filling Orders but will not be held responsible for more than the original amount paid for the Goods. Orders booked shall be void should Strikes Etc., make delivery impossible.

Claimes of any Nature must be made in writing within ten(10) days from the date shipment is received. Shipments travel at Purchasers risk and cost.

PACKING:

No extra charge for packing unless otherwise stated, packed light but secure enough for any method of Transportation, please state how to ship. We prefer Express charges collect but will ship by Parcel Post if possible when enough for postage is received with the Order.

Shipping Seasons:

Spring: About April 15th to May 31st.

Fall : About August 25th to November 15th.

Both seasons depending on Weather conditions.

Suggestions for growing Evergreens.

Rooted Cuttings, very small Transplants and seeding Evergreens should be shaded and watered for at least one year. One half shade is advised. Ground should be well worked and mellowed with Peat if very heavy. Large transplants can be Field rowed but should also be watered during dry weather if at all possible. All should be well cultivated to keep down the weeds and develop roots. Do not work the ground to late in the Fall as this will tend to keep the trees from hardening up for Winter. A Mulch is very beneficial. Commercial Fertilizers and fresh Barn Yard Manures can be used but care should be taken not to touch the roots.

Many of our Customers have asked us which trees are the best for Christmas Trees. The Trees used in this State, Minnesota and Upper Michigan are the Native Spruce, Black and White also Norway. The Norway Spruce is not native to this locality but it does very well here and grows fast.

Balsam Fir is the preferred Tree due to its Fragrance and Needle holding characteristics. Many Localities use other Trees such as the Austrian, Scotch and Norway Pine, Junipers and Firs in variety. The Pine hold their needles very well, stay green a long time and make very nice Xmass trees.

The Black Spruce and Balsam Fir do very well in wet swampy places as well as on the high ground. The Varieties in the greatest demand at the present time are first the Balsam Fir, Norway Spruce, White Spruce and Douglass Fir.

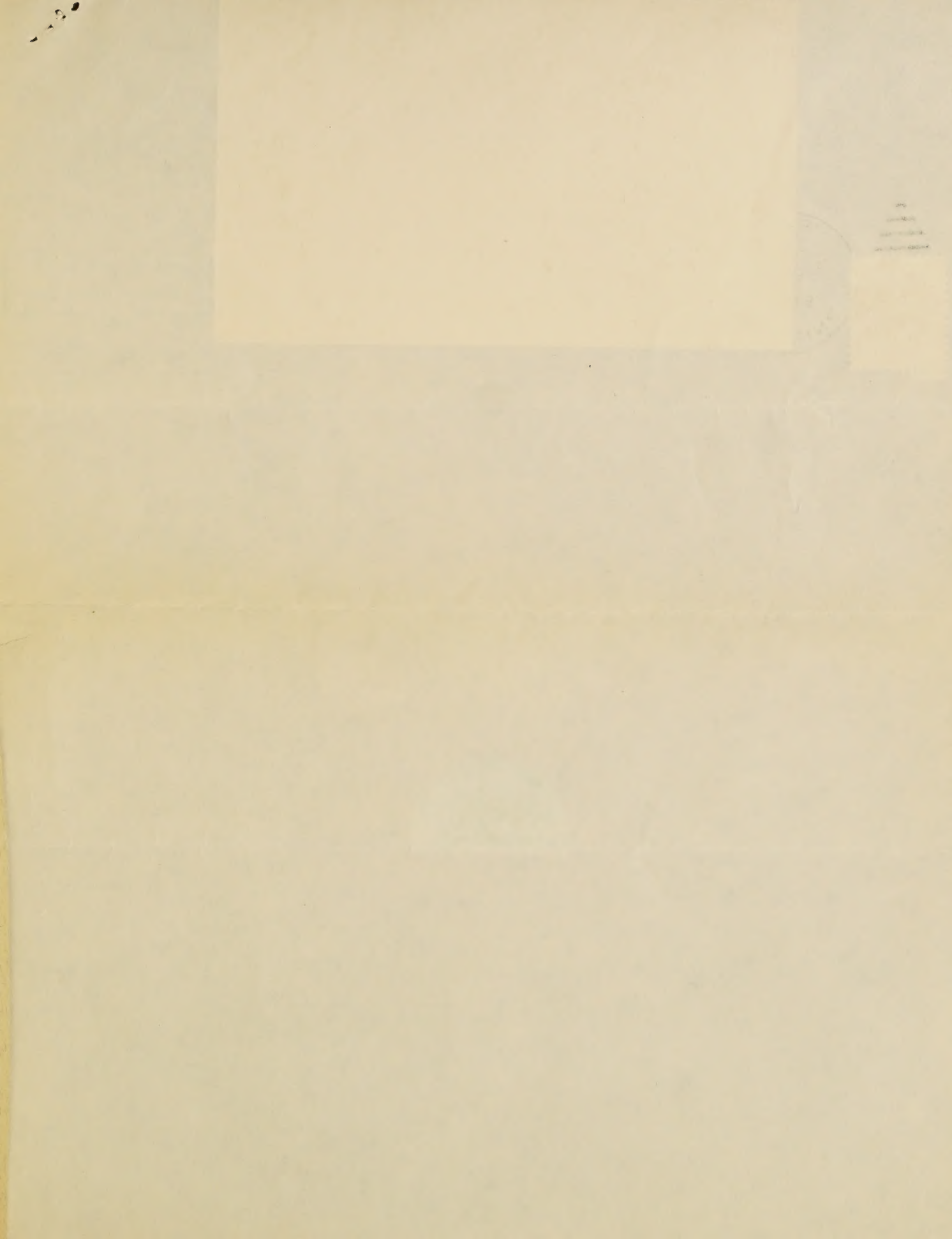

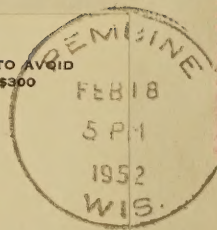
