MIXTURE

For best results sow alone and not with a grain crop. Under favorable conditions can be pastured in six weeks. Too heavy grazing will r e t a r d setting of permanent grasses. Contains Domestic Rye Grass, Orchard Grass, Ky. 31 Fescue, Ladino Clover and Perennial Rye Grass. Sow 30 to 35 pounds per acre.

SWEET SUDAN FOR SUMMER PASTURE

There is a need for more grazing on most Virginia farms during July and August. Sudan grass can help you provide additional grazing for your livestock during these critical pasture months because it grows best when permanent pastures are likely to be least productive. Sweet Sudan grass is the most satisfactory variety for Virginia conditions.

A third to one-half acre of Sudan grass will usually provide adequate grazing for one animal during the critical period. You can lengthen the productive period of this supplemental pasture by seeding half the acreage early and the remainder a month to six weeks later.

Sweet Sudan is adapted to a wide range of solids. However, it does best on a deep fertile soil with high water holding capacity. A good corn soil is a desirable soil for Sweet Sudan grass.

Fertilize well. Broadcast and disc in 600 to 800 pounds per acre of a 8-8-8 or 10-10-10 fertilizer.

Prepare a good seed bed much as you would for corn.

CERTIFIED ATLAS SORGO

Tall Growing Sorghurms. One of the best for Ensilage or as combination with Ensilage Corn. Plant with Corn at the rate of 5 to 15 pounds per acre. This will materially improve the quality and quantity of your Ensilage.

CERTIFIED EARLY COBINE HEGARI

105 Days. 4 Feet Tall

One of the most valuable grain Sorghums. It is ideal to harvest with livestock or turkeys. Sow 1 to 2 weeks after Corn planting. 12 to 15 lbs. per acre broad cast or 7 to 8 lbs. in 2 to 3 feet rows.

BLACK AMBER CANE GROWN FROM CERTIFIED SEED

Makes large yield of nutritious forage and can be fed green or cured. Not as tall and as coarse as Atlas Sorgo, but makes excellent Hay. When sown alone for Hay or Grass Silage, sow 50 pounds per acre.

CERTIFIED TALL HEGARI

120 Days, 5 to 6 feet Tall

Combination grain or forage Sorghum. It is eaten readily by animals either in pasturing off the fields after removal of grain heads or as harvested forage.

MARTIN'S COMBINE MILO

100 Days, Average Height 37 inches

Only recommended for grain. Will produce 30 to 60 bushels of grain per acre. Adapted to almost any type of soil. Plant in rows 36 to 42 inches using 5 to 6 pounds per acre. If planted in drill rows 18 to 20 inches apart, use 15 to 20 pounds per acre.

Fertilizer requirements for Sorghums same as for corn.

Remember Sorghums are drought resistant crops and will produce where corn fails.

SEED NOTES .-- SUPPLY

Poor harvesting weather in Europe, Asia and the United States drastically reduced World Wide Supplies of Clover, Alfalfa, Timothy, Perennial Ryegrass, White Clover and Orchard Grass.

Northern Europe and England have been heavy buyers of grasses and clovers. Normally, they are sellers.

Garden seed stocks — generally lower — due to heavy European demand — reduced seed supply.

Demand

Reduction in acreage of Wheat, Corn, Rice, and Tobacco has increased the acerage demand for grasses and legumes.

Larger numbers of Livestock will require more pasture and hay. Considerable Wheat acreage was not planted, due to weather.
