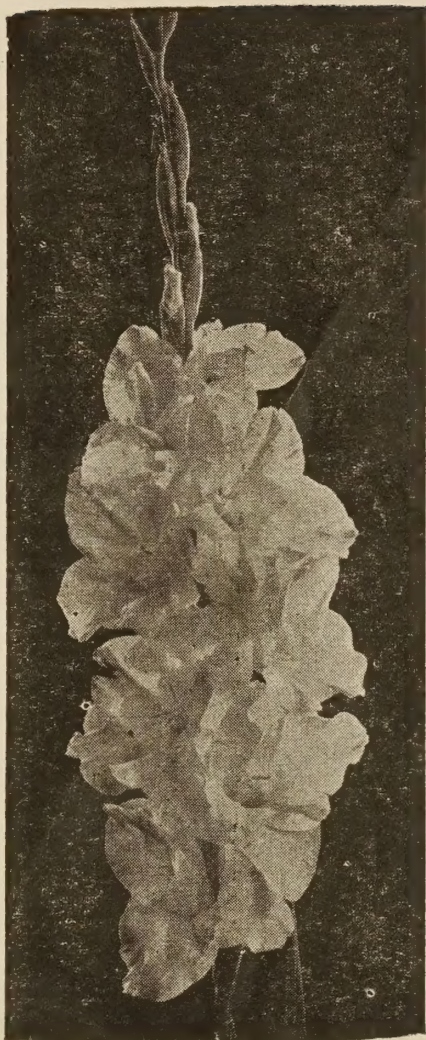

ALUMINUM WEATHERPROOF TAGS



Do you have trouble reading the names on your tags and stakes at the end of the season? If you do then these aluminum weather-proof tags will save you a lot of worry. These tags can always be easily read, and used year after year. These ALUMINUM TAGS engrave better and will last indefinitely. Many of our tags are buried under the dirt summer after summer and when they are removed we have no difficulty reading the variety name.

These tags are permanently engraved by writing on the aluminum side with an ordinary pencil and the name will be pressed into the aluminum. In case you make a mistake you may erase by removing the backing and press out the error. Wires furnished for each tag.

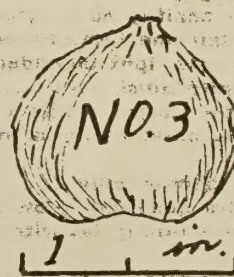
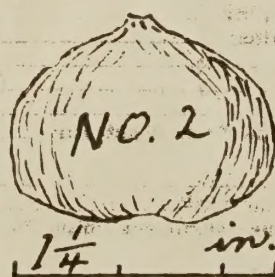
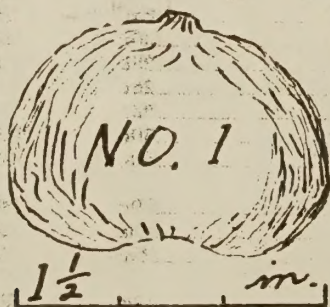
Priced at the rate of 2¢ each, but when accompanied by a bulb order we offer you a special price of 1½¢ each.

PLEASE READ BEFORE ORDERING

We urge that you place your orders early so that you may not be disappointed. Each year we are unable to fill late orders for a number of varieties. Orders are filled as received, first orders get the pick of my fine bulbs, stored in open sacks to be shipped after danger of freezing is past, unless you request otherwise. However bulbs can be shipped any time desired.

Cash with order, please; check or money order preferred. On orders of \$7.00 or more, 25% may be sent with order, balance payable before delivery. Orders of \$3.00 or more are PREPAID. On orders under \$3.00 we require an additional 35¢ for postage. NO wholesale list this season, but have many varieties in large quantities and will be most happy to quote price if you write your needs. All bulbs offered are top quality double STATE INSPECTED.

Regarding size of bulbs—LARGE are No. 1 and No. 2 assorted all over 1¼ inch in diameter; MEDIUM are No. 3 and No. 4 assorted between three-fourths of an inch to an inch & one-quarter. Small are No. 5 and No. 6 assorted between one-quarter to three quarters inch in diameter. Small bulbs usually bloom later in the season with smaller spikes. Bulblets cannot be counted upon to bloom, although some do. Buying bulblets is a cheap way to get started with a new variety, and they should make good bulbs for the following year.
