- Ageratum - Blue Ball Improved - large flowered medium blue- 75¢ doz.
- Blue Mink - New 1956 - Large powder blue flowers on 12 inch plants. 75¢ doz.
- Aster - Royal Mixed - early - good variety - 60¢ doz.
- American Branching - standard mid-season variety. 60¢ doz.
- Heart of France - beautiful garnet - 60¢ doz.
- Balsam - Bush, mixed. - double flowers well above leaves - 60¢ doz.
- Calendula - Pacific Beauty, mixed - 60¢ doz.
- Centaurea Americana (Batchelor Buttons) Mixed - 60¢ doz.
- Rosie - pink - 60¢ doz.
- Cleome - (Spider Plant) - Pink Queen - 60¢ doz.
- Coleus - Mixed - 6 plants, boxed, 50¢. See also potted plants
- Dahlia - Unwin Hybrids - dwarf dahlia from seed - 60¢ doz.
- Lobelia - Either bush or trailing - 75¢ doz.
- Marigold - all Marigolds 60¢ per dozen.
- Color Magic - yellow and orange marked with red - 10 in.
- Dwarf Mixed - good mixture - 6 to 8 inches
- Lemon Drop - canary yellow bloom - 6 to 8 inch plants
- Man-in-the-Moon - Large carnation flowered blooms, very pale yellow on 3 foot plants
- Parisian Hybrids - excellent variety - 12 to 15 inches
- Rusty Red - Deep mahogany with gilt edges, very popular variety - 12 to 15 inches
- Scarlet Glow - bright bronzy red flowers, double, on 12 to 15 inch plants.
- Tall African Double - mixed - growing to 3 feet, with large flowers
- Tangerine - bright tangerine blooms, 15 inch plants
- Treasure Chest - a mixture of various kinds, mostly of the larger sorts, good for cutting
- Yellow Supreme - large creamy yellow flowers. tall plants
- Nicotiana - (Flowering Tobacco) - Daylight - all white blooms, stay open during the day. Fragrant - 60¢ doz.
- Sensation mixed - white through pink to deep purple -
- Salvia - Rocket - dwarf, very early, blooms until frost- 60¢ doz.
- Blaze of Fire - very early and dwarf - 14 to 16 inches - 60¢
- Snapdragon - Majestic, Mixed - half-tall, good bloomer - 60¢ doz.
- Colossal - tall and sturdy - 60¢ doz.
- Verbena - Ideal Florists Strain - 60¢ doz.
- Torenia - Not well known, but an excellent border plant - 60¢ doz.



- Petunia - Mixed - Dwarf Mixed - single, low growing - 60¢ doz.  
 - Double mixed - \$1.25 doz.  
 - Paramount Giants - very large ruffled - 75¢ doz.
- Blue - Admiral - dwarf hybrid, medium blue - 60¢ doz.  
 - Black Knight - deep purple grandiflora - 75¢ doz.
- Red - Comanche - the reddest petunia to date - 75¢ doz.
- Rose - Prima Donna - new 1955 - all American Bronze winner - heavily ruffled bright rose flowers on vigorous base branching plants - 75¢ doz  
 - Celestial Rose - the good old standby, single low growing deep rose - 60¢ doz.  
 - Twinkles - single pink with white star - very free bloomer - 60¢ doz.
- White - La Paloma - excellent fringed white - 75¢ doz.  
 - Popcorn - single dwarf white - 60¢ doz.  
 - Paleface - New 1955 - pure white, very prolific bloomer, an outstanding plant. 75¢ doz.

- Tulips - Top-size bulbs in varieties which have been proved to be satisfactory in New England.
