













This is an actual photograph of Sullivan Clings, ripening on the C. E. Sullivan Ranch.

Little did we realize when press reports about these new developments appeared two years ago that Nugget and Carmelo would make walnut history. Frankly, when the extent of grower-interest became apparent we were forced to use all available budwood to build a supply of trees. Sale of the new varieties was withheld last season, although Sierra Gold customers were invited to order, and promised priority. These priority orders have taken most of our available trees this year (some Carmelo are on hand) so we can only suggest that you visit us and see these for yourself, placing orders for later delivery. Figure 20% deposit, please, and a minimum order of 50 trees for Nugget. Carmelo is available in any quantity.

NUGGET is our pride and joy . . . a sturdy tree that has given more than a ton per acre in its sixth year, (30 x 30 planting) far more than the normal sixth-year crop on Hartley. Nugget will be a real money-maker for growers. Tests show 53% meats, 100% large, Diamond quality.



We're in the business of growing peaches ourselves, and we think we know good peach trees when we see them. This year we have plenty (we hope) including 21 Freestone varieties (see back page) and 19 Clings, including the Sullivan #4 (above). We like to think that we "re-discovered" this fine late cling, although we admit that it has been a consistent money-maker in some Northern California orchards for many years. It's a proved producer, although it has never been "promoted" as have some other varieties.
