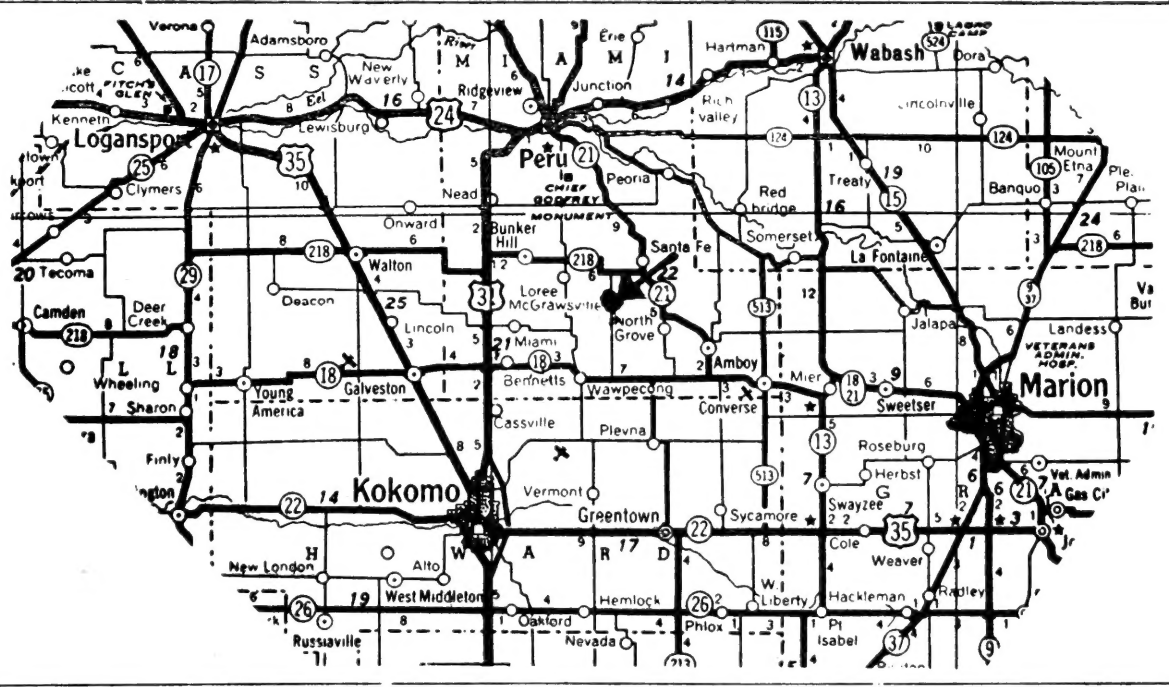

SOILENE—use on soil to rid soil from injurious insects, one treatment lasts for several months. Fine for garden use before planting. Reduces need to spray while plants are growing. Use early in spring. Fine for potted plants treat soil, takes care of insects. .60c per lb.; in lots of 25 lbs and up 50c lb.; .45c lb when picked up at greenhouse. 25 lbs and up shipped collect.
