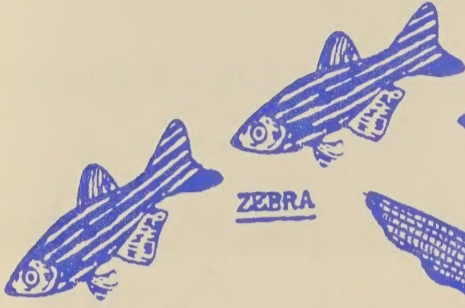

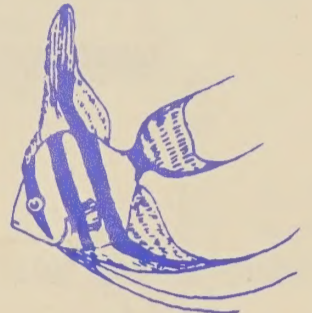

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR HANDLING FISH SHIPMENTS

1. Give us your ADDRESS & TELEPHONE NUMBER. Leave your TELEPHONE NUMBER with the Express Co., or local Airline so they can call you immediately on arrival of shipment.
2. Have a clear aquarium set up with seasoned water ready for your fish on arrival. Carefully remove the fish from shipping can placing them in a small bowl or two with water from shipping can. Strain the remainder of the water from the can into the aquarium. Do not use the water if it is sour or polluted. Float the small bowls or jars (containing the fish) in your aquarium until the temperature in the jars and the aquarium is the same. then release the fish. In a newly set up aquarium, it is wise to add a teaspoonful of salt for every 5 gallons of water. Dissolve the salt in a separate container before adding to aquarium. This small amount will not harm Plants or Snails and will act as a tonic for fish.

3. EXAMINE FISH SHIPMENT CAREFULLY ON ARRIVAL for signs of "ROUGH HANDLING" such as:

<u>Bruised Fish</u>	<u>Can Turned over</u>	<u>Etc.</u>

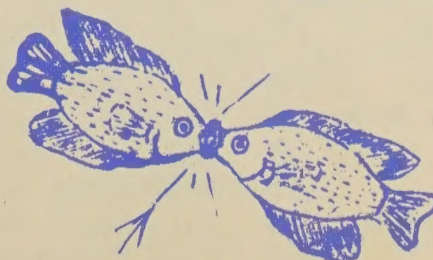
If such is the case, get a proper Bad Order Report from the expressman stating "rough handling!" This gives you grounds for claim in case of losses.

AND HOW TO HANDLE ON ARRIVAL

MADAGASCAR DWARF AQUA. LILY



In planting an aquarium, tall plants are usually placed in the background with the shorter plants in front. Vallisnerias as well as some types of Sagittarias are usually used in the background. We offer many decorative plants to be used as center plants. The type used depends on the size of the aquarium and the personal desires of the individual



Vallisneria.

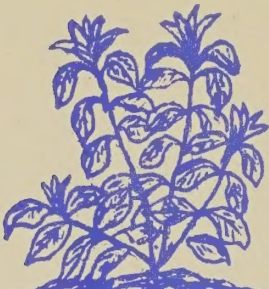
BUNCHED PLANTS consist of several sprigs tied together with a piece of lead. Remove the lead and push each sprig into the sand where it will root. Plants sold as cuttings also root when planted in the aquarium.

FLOATING PLANTS such as Salvinia, Water Hyacinths, Water Lettuce, Floating Water Fern, etc. should be allowed to float even though they have roots. Do not plant them!

LIGHT

Lack of sunlight is one of the greatest causes of plant spoilage. With few exceptions, Aquarium Plants require from 3 to 5 hours of sunlight each day or the equivalent in strong electric light in which the light bulb is placed directly over the surface of the aquarium water. Plants kept without some sunlight or direct artificial light usually deteriorate.

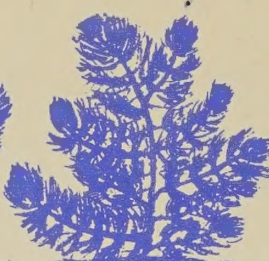
Sunshine is also necessary for the good health of fish. Some varieties contract the disease known as "Rickets" because of the lack of sunlight. Fish with this disease look caved-in and seem to have hollow stomachs.



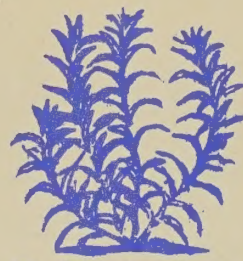

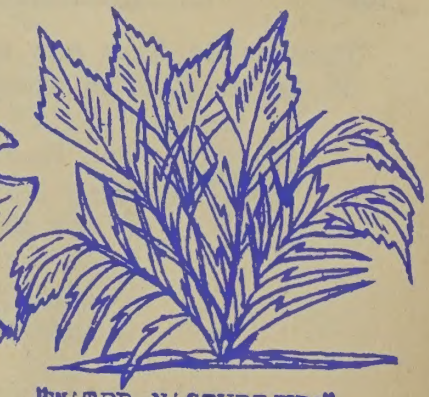
