

YOUR LAWN . . . What to Do and When to Do It

EARLY SPRING

We recommend early feeding of your lawn to assure a strong, healthy growth of the grasses that have been dormant all winter. It is best to apply a well balanced fertilizer at



this time to provide deep roots, sturdy blades and rich color. The application should be made with a spreader to assure a more even distribution. It is not necessary to water the fertilizer in at this time to prevent "burn" because the grass is dormant. The Spring thaws, snow and rain will work the fertilizer down to the roots. Proper fertilizing will mean a thicker and healthier lawn, consequently less weed and crabgrass problems later. Most lawns on Long Island require lime applications annually.

SPRING

Spring seeding of lawns should be done as early as weather and soil conditions permit. Soil should be spaded or tilled to a depth of five to eight inches. Rake thoroughly to remove large stones, roots and other waste material. If soil has a tendency to cake it is advisable to add peat moss or other humus to the soil to increase the fertility. When this has been completed, a good fertilizer, preferably one with a high organic content, should be spread over the area. Rake in the fertilizer leaving a fine mellow surface. Now comes the seeding, this is most important, select a good mix-



ture containing a very high percentage of perennial grasses such as Fescues, Kentucky Bluegrass, Highland Bent, Clover optional. Top quality grasses are the most economical in the end because of the greater percentage of good live seeds and the greater area coverage per pound. Rake in gently, roll lightly and sprinkle with a fine spray.

Old lawns should be raked vigorously in the Spring, removing dead grass, weeds and other waste, loosening the soil in bare spots. More seed should be spread in the bare spots and thin areas and rake in lightly. The entire area is now ready for a good application of

high organic fertilizer. Sprinkle the area with a light rain spray to wash in fertilizer and aid in the germinaton of the new seed.

SUMMER

Crabgrass, an ugly and dangerous growth in your lawn, should no longer be a problem to remove. In the past few years, fine chemical killers have been found to easly control this problem. However it is very important that the instructions on these various materials be carefully followed to insure success. We have selected the two which are considered the most

insure success. We have selected the two which are considered the most efficient, namely Scotts Scutl and Potassium Cynate. Scutl can be easily applied by spreader while PC must be sprayed. It would be advisable to make a moderate application of a good fertilizer at this time to tide over this critical period.

FALL

Generally speaking this is the better time for seeding of new lawns because grass seeds germinate and grow better in cool wet weather. The time element is also a decided advantage. Hot weather, weeds and crabgrass are no longer a problem at this time.

Preparation of the soil bed is important. In hard clay-like soils it is advisable to add peat moss, humus, or other organics to the soil to create a mellow, fertile soil. This improves



drainage and also permits the young grass roots to develop under more ideal conditions. Spading or plowing to a depth of five to eight inches is recommended. All large stones, roots and other waste materials should be raked out, leaving a level, mellow seed bed. Now, we are ready for the fertilizing, which is often neglected. Obtain a good grade of fertilizer, preferably a high organic 10-6-4, be liberal in applying and rake in thoroughly.

Seeding, which is practically the last procedure in the building of lawns should be done carefully. First of all, secure the best grass seed mixtures available, that is mixtures which are high in perennials such as Kentucky Bluegrass, Fescues, Highland Bentgrass, Clover is optional. The best grass

mixtures which are higher in price nevertheless are more economical in as much as the higher purity of the seed permits a greater number of live seeds per pound. We highly recommend Scott Seeds as tops and justly proven so. A good lawn seeder will give you an evener distribution of the seed. Rake gently and sprinkle with a fine spray. Light rolling after raking may be advisable.
