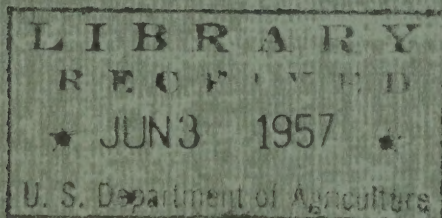

FRUIT DEPARTMENT

Marshalls grow Better Built Trees. Our fruit trees are grown by the cut-back method. Our best grade of apple, cherry and pear trees are mostly 3 years old -- our plums, peaches and apricots 2 years old --- a year older than fruit trees handled by many other concerns.

SPECIMEN GRADE is our best grade of well-headed, 5 to 6 ft. trees. Cherry are 4½ to 5 ft.

SELECT GRADE is a #1 tree 4 to 6 ft. Cherry 3½-4 ft.

STANDARD GRADE is our smallest grade 4 to 5 ft. trees, cherry around 3½ ft.

PLUM VARIETIES

It is beneficial to have more than one variety in a planting to get good pollination. Superior is one of the best for cross-pollinating other varieties. (Sapa is a bush type.)
