Grow in shade and soil about as phylodendron. Requires liberal watering and feeding. \$1.25



MALATHION — 50% liquid form. This spray is efficient both for potted plants and garden use. Does not leave residue longer than 10 days. When spraying is completed, pour the solution around plant on soil, this prevents insects from harboring at roots of plants. This is the only efficient spray for Mealy Bug that we have found. Be sure to wet the infested spots well, one spray will be effective. \$1.25

VC 13 — For nemetodes in soil. For soil; have soil free of hard clods, sprinkle solution on soil until thoroughly dampened clear through. Let stand 10 days before using, when plants are potted water with VC solution at once, be sure to wet soil thoroughly. For potting soil use 2 tablespoons to each gallon of water. For watering plants in pots use 4 teaspoons to 1 gallon of water. Repeat when needed. This will not injure foliage. 8 oz. \$2.50
