ACAJAU — very broad fern pattern of sil-  
 very green on a dark mahogany  
 background.  
 FULGIDA — large brown leaves with  
 bright silvery green veins.  
 SILVER SHEEN — leaves bright silver.  
 VIRIDIFOLIA — smooth nile green leaves,  
 profuse bloomer.  
 CUPREATA — hairy, coppery leaves in  
 good light  
 EMERALD QUEEN — hairy emerald green  
 leaves, narrow silver mid rib and  
 veins.  
 FROSTY — frosted, downy, emerald green  
 leaves with wide silver mid rib.  
 HARLEQUIN — smooth, shiny leaves, dark  
 brown edges with central, pattern of  
 greenish white.  
 SYLVAN BEAUTY — silvery green leaves  
 with medium brown margins.  
 SPLENDENS — (Silver Queen) robust  
 grower with emerald green leaf and  
 broad silver markings.  
 DIANTHAFLOA — small leaf, long trail-  
 ing growth, deeply serrated white  
 bloom.  
 E. LILICINA — Blue Flowers  
 PANAMA (chontalensis) — small dark  
 green leaves, light blue fringed flow-  
 ers, fall bloomer.  
 LILACCINA — large soft hairy bronze  
 leaves, flowers large.

 ening white spade-like flowers, good  
 for patio, planting bins, etc., a plant  
 that grows well even in air condition-  
 ing. Grow in shade and soil about as  
 phylodendron. Requires liberal water-

SMITH BRONX SPRAYER—a hand sprayer or mister for all hand spraying operations. \$1.95

SPAGNUM MOSS — the fine milled spagnum for sowing seed. Large size. 10 lb. bag \$2.50

ROOTONE — for dipping cuttings for propagation. 25¢ and stamped envelope.

SODIUM SELENATE — material for 1 gal. solution. Use as directed. 50¢ P.P.

PLANT MARVEL — 1/2 lb. 80¢; 1 lb. \$1.35

RAPID GROW — 6 oz. 50¢ 1 lb. \$1.30

MALATHION — 50% liquid form. This spray is efficient both for potted plants and garden use. Does not leave residue longer than 10 days. When spraying is completed, pour the solution around plant on soil, this prevents insects from harboring at roots of plants. This is the only efficient spray for Mealy Bug that we have found. Be sure to wet the infested spots well, one spray will be effective. \$1.25

VC 13 — For nematodes in soil. For soil; have soil free of hard clods, sprinkle solution on soil until thoroughly dampened clear through. Let stand 10 days before using, when plants are potted water with VC solution at once, be sure to wet soil thoroughly. For potting soil use 2 tablespoons to each gallon of water. For watering plants in pots use 4 teaspoons to 1 gallon of water. Repeat when needed. This will not injure foliage. 8 oz. \$2.50
