## RED FLOWERS

ACAJAU - very broad fern pattern of silvery green on a dark mahogany background.
FULGIDA - large brown leaves with bright silvery green veins.
SILVER SHEEN - leaves bright silver.
VIRIDIFOLIA - smooth nile green leaves, profuse bloomer.
CUPREATA - hairy, coppery leaves in good lighi
EMERALD QUEEN - hairy emerald green leaves, narrow silver mid rib and veins.
FROSTY - frosted, downy, emerald green leaves with wide silver mid rib.
HARLEQUIN - smooth, shiny leaves, dark brown edges with central, pattern of greenish white.
SYLVAN BEAUTY - silvery green leaves with medium brown margins.
SPLENDENS - (Silver Queen) robust grower with emerald green leaf and broad silver markings.
DIANTHAFLORA - small leaf, long trailing growth, deeply serrated white bloom.
E. LILICINA - Blue Flowers

PANAMA (chontalensis) - small dark green leaves, light blue fringed flowers, fall bloomer.
LILACCINA - large soft hairy bronze leaves, flowers large.
lilacina (Mrs. Fanny Haage) - beautiful tan foliage with light green center All the above Episcia are $75 \notin$ each.

## OXALIS

O. REGNALLI - large trifoliate, truncate cut off squarely) red underside foliage nearly or quite evergreen and everblooming, large white flowers. $50 \phi$
O. RUBRA - low stemless growth lovely clover like dark green trifoliate foliage large deep rose, likes sun. $50 ¢$
O. BASKET TRAILER - stems very dark, small trifoliate leaves set on large $2^{\prime \prime}$ fleshy stems, everblooming small deep yellow flowers. $50 \phi$
PANDANUS VEITCHI-foliage plant, does well in poor light. Long leaves striped in white: flowers on top of soil look like carved wood. $\$ 1.00$

PILEA SPRUCEANA (Panamegia) - dark brownish green quilted puffed leaves low growing plant with very small greenish flowers in clusters fanning out from center of leaves. $50 \phi$
CEROPEGIA (The Rosary vine) - heart shaped leaves are penciled in white pattern, flowers and sets bulbs on runners. $50 ¢$

NORWOOD - also called fluffy ruffles. compact, upright growth.

Bloms March through June, with glistening white spade-like flowers, good for patio, planting bins, etc., $\alpha$ plant that grows well even in air conditioning. Grow in shade and soil about as phylodendron. Requires liberal watering and feeding. $\$ 1.25$

HUMIDITY GUAGE - for measuring humidity in a room, this is sometimes vital for the successful culture of plants. $\$ 1.29$
SMITH BRONX SPRAYER-a hand sprayer or mister for all hand spraying operations. \$1.95
SPAGNUM MOSS - the fine milled spagum for sowing seed. Large size. 10 lb . bag \$2.50
ROOTONE - for dipping cuttings for propigation. $25 \phi$ and stamped envelope.
SODIUM SELENATE - material for 1 gal. solution. Use as directed. $50 \phi$ P.P.
PLANT MARVEL - $1 / 2 \mathrm{lb} .80 \$$; $1 \mathrm{lb} . \$ 1.35$
RAPID GROW - $6 \mathrm{oz} .50 \$ 1 \mathrm{lb} . \$ 1.30$
MALATHION - $50 \%$ liquid form. This spray is efficient both for potted plants and garden use. Does not leave residue longer than 10 days. When spraying is completed, pour the solution around plant on soil, this prevents insects from harboring at roots of plants. This is the only efficient spray for Mealy Bug that we have found. Be sure to wet the infested spots well, one spray will be effective. $\$ 1.25$
VC 13 - For nemetodes in soil. For soil; have soil free of hard clods, sprinkle solution on soil until thoroughly dampened clear through. Let stand 10 days before using, when plants are potted water with VC solution at once, be sure to wet soil thoroughly. For potting soil use 2 tablespoons to each gallon of water. For watering plants in pots use 4 teaspoons to 1 gallon of water. Repeat when needed. This will not injure foliage. 8 oz . $\$ 2.50$
