MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Security Research Staff

SUBJECT : Project MERRIMACK

1. This memorandum confirms the verbal report on the continuing coverage being afforded the above captioned subject on activities monitored for 13 April 1967.

2. The sit-in teacher's meeting held at American University from 9:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on 13 April was attended by one of our assets. There were three speakers: [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] has participated in a number of demonstrations in this area and seems very radical in his views. The topics of the three speakers centered around how the CIA uses schools and how they fund and donate money to various causes. [REDACTED] spoke of the "black man doing the white man's fighting, taking the brunt for the white man". The speeches were definitely anti-Vietnam in nature. There were about one hundred people present, including three Negroes (one of whom was our asset).
