
SUBJECT

: Poor Peoples Campaign.

1. During the MALCOLM X day gathering at Meridian Park, 15th and Euclid Streets, NW, Washington, D.C., meetings were held in an orderly fashion but the speeches were violent and anti-Government. An individual named stating that black people should kill President Johnson, Hubert Humphrey and George Wallace. For your information, pictures were taken of this individual and are presently being developed. Anti-religious remarks were made and the Red Chinese slogan of getting power by bricks and guns was repeated by the speaker.

2. Approximately 200 people were in attendance at this gathering, 95% of whom were colored, and their attitude was that of indignation and anger. Possibly more may have come out of the meeting had not a sudden thunder shower dispursed the crowd.
