1. [At a meeting of the WSP on 13 December 1967, at the home of WSP member [REDACTED], Washington, D.C., [REDACTED] addressed the group. She identified herself as an employee of the United States Department of Justice. In her brief talk, she denounced the present Administration, the President, Secretary of State and the Government in general. She stated that she had personal knowledge that during the 21 October 1967 demonstration there were over 200 CIA, FBI and Pentagon force personnel interspersed in the demonstration process in order to create difficulties which could reflect adversely on the [REDACTED].

2. The major portion of the meeting revolved around plans for the forthcoming Janet RALPH Brigade demonstration and also for the opening session of Congress, 15 January 1968. Local headquarters for this demonstration have been established in the home of [REDACTED] Washington, D.C.

3. It was announced at this meeting that a Northern Virginia Chapter of the WSP had been created [REDACTED]

4. As further details are developed, they will be reported.
