

SPECIAL INFORMATION

On 6 December 1968 a source of unknown reliability volunteered information regarding the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) at George Washington University.

Source advised that the active membership of this organization at George Washington University is approximately one hundred, but that the strength of the SDS, counting sympathizers, is between four and five hundred. He further advised that the SDS plans to organize a mass demonstration to disrupt the Presidential Inauguration in January 1969, and it was his opinion that the SDS may link up with the black militant groups in the Washington, D. C. area. Source also expressed the opinion that the demonstration would lead to riots which may possibly be as severe as those of April 1968. The Student Council at George Washington University, in anticipation of a serious disorder, has asked the University Administration to schedule fall semester exams prior to the Inauguration.

Source also related that he was a spectator at a recent speech given by [REDACTED]. During a fight involving [REDACTED] the latter's shirt came open and revealed that [REDACTED] was carrying a concealed pistol in a shoulder holster.
