25X1X [redacted] 2. Between 24 June and 1 July, the SS Kaserne Wilder Mann, Dresden, was occupied by about 600 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets and 100 troops wearing black-bordered black epaulets. [redacted] 25X1

3. Between 22 June and 2 July, the Riesa, Oschatz and Grimma posts again were occupied to capacity.³ and 4 The Zeithain training grounds was occupied by a small number of Soviet troops. Billeting equipment was continually shipped away to the military posts.³ 25X1X

4. On 4 July, 2 x 122-mm field guns, 4 x 100-mm AT guns, 7 prime movers, 8 trucks and about 150 troops were entrained at the Gera railroad station. The shipment left for Ohrdruf at 12:50 p.m.⁵ On 6 July, 3 x 100-mm AT guns, 5 prime movers, 2 trucks, 1 boxcarload of ammunition and about 60 troops were unloaded from a train which, with 12 boxcars occupied by troops and 14 motor vehicles [redacted] and [redacted] went on toward Glauchau.⁶ 25X1B 25X1
