[Redacted] the Chinese Communists established a weather station approximately two miles north-northwest of Wukung (N 27-39, E 117-52) on the site of the former Chinese Nationalist Wu I (2976/1138) weather observation station. The weather observation station was staffed by an anti-aircraft unit of approximately 100 men who were quartered in caves and temples in the vicinity.
