- 3. Staff Position: The Office of General Counsel (OGC) has delivered an opinion that training of personnel for post-separation employment may be authorized "if based on security considerations and limited in scope." It is a further opinion of the OGC that a requisite justification for the expenditure of Government funds could not be established in this particular case.
- 4. Recommendation: That the request for external training be disapproved and the attached memorandum be forwarded to Mr. 25X1A
