On 9 and 14 January 1952, only a few soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, including some with tank insignia, were noticed at the Panzer Kaserne, Borna (N 52/K 39). Source was prevented from approaching the installation closely. At noon of 14 January, he observed 2 officers, 1 NCO and 32 PM leaving the installation. The troops wore red-bordered black epaulets and carried submachine guns and firing equipment. Truck [redacted] occupied by soldiers with red-bordered black epaulets, moved through the barracks gate. 25X1
