
- During the paried from lay to September 19h7 three light phenomena happening at intervals of about 15 minutes were seen almost every might between 9 at 10 p.m. local time. The phenomena were weathed from the Fi carp in Feldria Aral, about 50 km scatterest of Teathernt (hl\*0.512/69\*0.512), Unbok 3.5.R., in an east-scattheasterly direction.
- A darked ball of fire was seen first; after about six seconds it reached the spex of a long-drawn out trajectory. During this time the ball had developed a trail of fire. Its color, which was bright red at the spex point, changed in oblor from pale green to white. Smoke trails, noises, or detomations new not noticed.
