As you Americans do not want to tell us what the so stupidly called 'flying saucers' are, and above all, what they cost (and this may be very important in the future), I need your excellent telescope for myself and my observation group which I am just creating.

The UFO (Unidentified Flying Objects) are coming more and more over this country, and owing perhaps to the very nature of this land and its beautiful nights, we have had more often in the sky than the busy Americans.

When telling me the prices, please remember that the package must be always extra-plain, because otherwise the local officials may destroy the telescope even before it reaches us."


