## SOURCE

1. About 10 PM on the night of 20 Jul 55, while enroute from Langdon to Moscow by train, we saw a bright light in the air which was trailed by a long tail of black smoke. It was much too bright for a plane. It may have been five to 15 miles distant and was under two thousand feet above ground.
2. We inquired of our guide what it was but got only a humorous reply that it was probably a flying saucer. The guide was "Ivlev" who had been with a party of which I was a member on a previous trip. Whether he knew what it was could not be determined.
