

## REPORT OF THE SCIENTIFIC PARKEL

UNICHMINIST PLANS COUNCES

## 17 January 1953

- The undersigned Funel of Scientifis Commutants has not at the request of the Coverment to evaluate any possible threat to national security posed by Maismitting Plining Diotest (Thying Saucers), and to make recommendation. The Funel has received the oridance as presented by continue forevenuebul agencies, primarily the United Coutes Air Turms, and has reviewed a selection of the best commended incidents.
  - As a result of its considerations, the Panel concludes:
     That the evidence presented on Unidentified Flying

That the evidence presented on Unidentified Flying Objects shows no indication that these pheacems constitute a direct physical threat to national security.

We firmly believe that there is no residuum of cases which indicates phenomena which are stributable to foreign artifacts capable of hostile acts, and that there is no oridance that the phenomena indicate a need for the revision of current meioriffic concepts.

3. In the light of this conclusion, the Panel recommends:

That the national security agencies take immediate steps to strip the Unidentified Flying Colocts of the special status they have been given and the sure of systemy they have unfortunately acquired.

We suggest that this ein may be echieved by an integrated program designed to reseave the public of the total lack of evidence of intuical forces behind the phononeum.
