Thank you for your letter of 1: Seatember 1955 with which you enclosed a letter to you from Thomas H. Eichholf.

The questions which Mr. Electhoff has reliesd in his letter to you are largely outside of the juriviletion of this dependy. Lection 102(d) of the National Generity Act of 1947 provides that 51.4 has no police, subpeak, lawernforcement powers, or internal-security functions. Insolar as Mr. Elekhoff appears intractive pursuing the problem of mail frand in connection with George Adamsid's book entitled "inside The Space' hips , it would appear to be a problem of law-enforcement, from which we are specifically barred by status.

GD, as a matter of policy, does not comment on the truth or falsity of material evaluated in backs or other publiched statements, and therefore it is not in a position to comment on Mr. Adamski's book or the subtenticity of the pictures which it contains.

The subject matter of Mr. Adamski's book would appear to be more in the jurisdiction of the Perartment of Defence and the National Science Foundation, and it may be that you would wish to refer some of these quotions to them for consideration.
