Reurlet dated January 15, 1957, captioned "Security Investigations," requesting permission to continue maintenance of certain of your old Communist Index (CI) cards which would not be included in the revised CI.

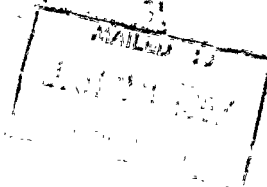
It is noted that among the cards which you desire to retain are those on all past and present Security Index (SI) subjects. Maintenance in the revised CI of cards on present SI subjects would constitute a duplication and these cards should not be so retained.

It is further noted that the principal basis for your desire to retain these old CI cards is for their utilization for documentation purposes. Since no effort should be expended to keep CI cards in a current state, the use of such cards for documentation purposes could very possibly lead to failure to utilize in documentation the most up-to-date information available. In this connection, neither the old nor the revised CI was or is intended to supplant the general indices in your office or to short-circuit file reviews when such file reviews are necessary. The purpose of revising the CI as stated in SAC Letter 56-56 is to make the Index serve as an administrative aid and working index without allowing it to become unwieldy. It is believed that careful analysis of the categories set out in SAC Letter 56-56 should enable you to formulate a workable and efficient CI which will meet the functions such Index is devised to perform.
