*Security Index -*

SAC Letter #57 dated April 10, 1948, instructed each Division to prepare a Communist index to be maintained in alphabetical order. In complying with the instruction, no problem exists with respect to the inclusion in this index of individuals on whom we have current evidence of membership or activity. On the other hand, there exists another category of cases concerning individuals on whom there is evidence of membership in 1947, no evidence of activity in 1948, but no positive evidence that the Communist affiliation has definitely ceased.

The Phoenix Division desires to obtain the Bureau's decision relative to the inclusion or elimination of individuals in the latter category in the Communist Index.

Also, in connection with the Communist Index, the Phoenix Division believes that a real purpose would be served in maintaining an index of former Communist party members in our territory. Such a list would provide CNDI prospects and further provide a readily available list of possible witnesses in connection with Communist party activity.

It is desired to suggest that the Bureau authorize the field to maintain the Communist Index in three sections (arranged alphabetically within each section):

- Section I All Communists within the Division on whom there is evidence of current membership or activity.
- Section II Doubtful cases where there is evidence of membership or activity in the previous year, but no such evidence for the current year.
- Section III Former members - individuals for whom there is no evidence of activity or membership in the current year or the preceeding year.

This is to advise that a review of the Communist Index of the Phoenix Office has been made in accordance with instructions set out in referenced letter.

This review has been completed and the Phoenix Division Communist Index presently totals 64. This sum is made up of 45 individuals formerly on Security Index who have been removed since April, 1955, plus 19 other individuals who fall within the designated criteria.

Communist Index cards have been made up on these individuals and appropriate files marked "RCI". The remaining Communist Index cards have been destroyed as instructed by the Bureau.
