"I'm glad you like it!" replied Augie, eagerly, "because I'm going to fix dinner for you every night this week!"

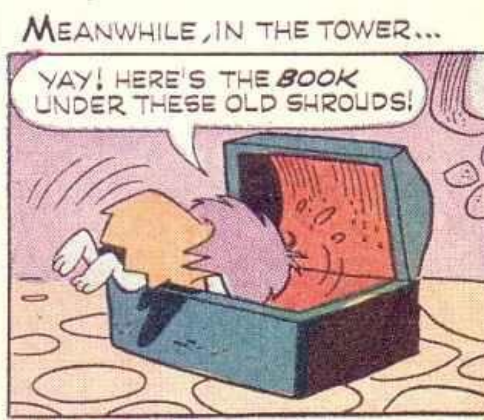
Poor pop suppressed a groan and said, "But, son of mine, I'm going on a diet of raw vegetables and ice cream for a month."

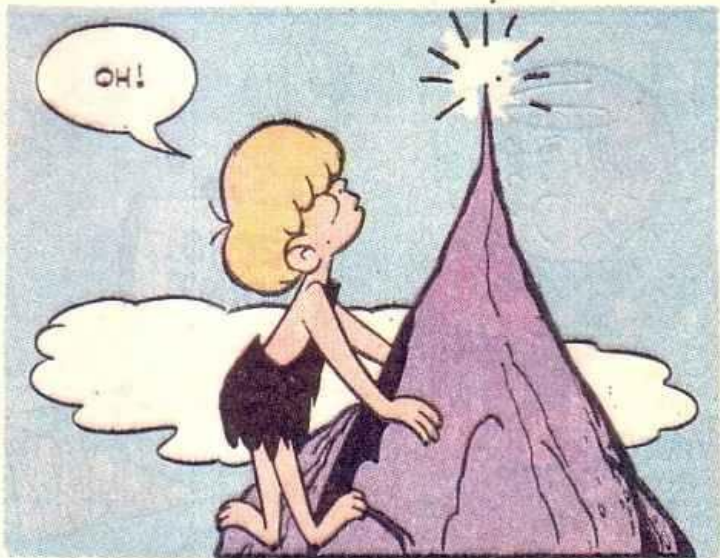
