


ISm sure it boils down to the fact that people TTRE7THTS are so insecure with-themselves that they are either scared or jealous when they see some one with guts to different than everyone else.

VERY so often, a new MP is labelled by his associates in the ✓ House of Commons as someone whose career will influence the life of his party and his country. His questions and interventions in Commons debates are observed with special attention. His demeanour and personality are scrutinized for the intangibles that can mould raw talent into the makings of leadership. The media wrap their clichés around him, describing him as a "comer," a rising star."

\_ed MPs. The average age of party's MPs fell from forty-eight in 1974 to forty-two in 1980.

But most of the new crop represent ridings in British Columbia, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba, where the party made important gains in the last two elections. Of the group, only Rae, Neil Young, and Ian Deans are from Ontario, where the future of the NDP as a national force will be determined. Geography, therefore, coupled with his past, his dis-

tinguished family, his evident intelligence, and his swiftly established record for political success have designated Rae as the federal New Democrat of whom much is expected.

"I don't think of myself as the heir apparent," he says. "Most of the unhappy people I know are those who fix themselves a certain goal and then are shattered if they don't make it. Broadbent is the party leader. The caucus and party are solidly behind him. He'll be the leader for as long as he wants it. Talking about the leadership is an abstract

Guided by more modest expectations than either the Liberals or Conservatives, the New Democrats do not demand high standards of electoral success from their leaders. That part of the NDP psyche that considers the party a movement for social and economic reform believes that electoral success is

only one yardstick by which a leader should be measured. Even if Rae were flush with ambitions of leadership, he would have no alternative but to wait until Broadbent is ready to leave. That day still seems some distance away.
