Mt. Olivet Methodist Episcopal Church - Droop Mt.

Mt. Olivet, a Methodist Episcopal church, is situated on Droop Mountain about a mile from the Pocahontas-Greenbrier line on Route # 219. It is a log church and was built in 1860.

The deed for the land is recorded in D. B. 13 page 385-
Jan. 30, 1860. Joseph B. Dean & Hannah Dean to John F. May,
James C. Shedegar, William Shisler, James W. Shisler, and
George Caraway, Trustees, for the use and benefit of the
Methodist Episcopal Church, to be kept and used by the ministers
and members of the said church, and to be free to all orthodox
churches when not occupied by them of the other part. - A par-
cel of land containing one and one-half acres.

when the new road was built, the church was very
badly damaged, so due to the influence of the Rev. Ward who
was the pastor at this time, the church was rebuilt and re-
dedicated. It was dedicated in 1903 and the Rev. Ellis
presided at the dedicatory service. Mr. Andrew Price made a
speech at the rededication. The crowd was so large that
he had to stand outside on the steps so that everyone could
hear him. There have never been any records kept in this
church that anyone knows about. This, too, was a reason for
the rededication.

The church has a membership of about seventy-five
persons. There are preaching services here the second
Sunday of each month. The Rev. Fenney is the pastor at the
present time.
