16 Defendant Jeff Kepley was named in his representative capacity as the Chief
17 of Police for the City of Palos Verdes Estates, and that in late August 2017,
18 Defendant Jeff Kepley formally resigned and vacated the office of Chief of Police
19 for the City of Palos Verdes Estates. And, on the date Jeff Kepley retired, Captain
20 Mark Velez was serving as the acting Chief of Police, officially succeeded to and
21 now lawfully occupies the office of Chief of Police until the Defendant City of Palos
22 Verdes Estates appoints a new acting, interim, or permanent Chief of Police.

23 It appearing to the court that Mark Velez should be substituted as defendant in
24 this action in his representative capacity as Chief of Police pursuant to Fed. R. Civ.
25 P. 25(d)(1) until such a time a new acting, interim, or permanent Chief of Police is
26 named; therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Mark Velez be substituted as defendant in
