Today, our staff met with Deputy District Attorney Angie Christides, of the LADA's Office, Hardcore Gang Division out of the Compton court house. She visited to learn more about our localism surfer issues and to assess the use of gang prosecutions on these crimes. While much more work needs to be done, she believes that the future crimes related to surfer localism can, and should, be prosecution with gang enhancements. This is welcome news! I firmly believe that if we prosecuted only one case in this fashion, with publicity, it would be the first and strongest effort to date to dissuade others from committing similar offenses. We will be compiling data and criminal intelligence on this case and preparing two officers to be further trained in this special discipline, then work closely with DDA Christides throughout the year until we have a high surf which is when we will likely have some of these types of crimes.
