future story that he left around Wednesday midnight, a time when the sawmill workers would be down in the town, drinking.

In apite of years of neglect, esrithquakos, vendelism and demega from time, what romoins of the Alhembe still possestes the beouty and intricate core which the Moers put inte their work.

In 1931. Spein issued e sit of 10 themps in sommemorution of the third Pon-Americen Postal Union Cengress. The designs used on most of the stomps in
 landmarks and plaees of interest. Two of the stamps in this sof bore repliee of the beatiful "Fountein of the Lions" which the Moors bullt in their ancient citedel of the Ahembre.
