

Tuesd. May 29, 1951

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Mr. [redacted] delivered copies of the minutes of the meeting on 23 May to Mr. [redacted] of OPC who said he would call if he had any comments or questions.

Mr. [redacted] delivered copies of the minutes to General [redacted] who consented to serve as Chairman of the Committee until Dr. [redacted] returns.

General [redacted] raised the following points:

1. Should the personnel briefed on Bluebird be increased to include the Division Chiefs of CSO? The possibilities might not be realized if those with knowledge of it were too limited in number.
2. Should we consider a wider distribution of the Bluebird List so that those briefed would know all the others who were briefed?
3. At the same time a re-issue of Mr. [redacted] memo describing Bluebird security might be desirable.
4. Does the current list represent a practical set of briefing classifications? Possible alternative
  - a. Full knowledge
  - b. Knowledge of team projects
  - c. The Subject in general.
5. Mr. [redacted] should keep notes which can be used as the agenda at the next meeting.
6. Correction to Minutes of Meeting on 23 May 1951:
  - p. 2 - Dr. [redacted] is in the Philadelphia, as a practitioner. He might be a source of applicants or a candidate for employment.  
The Valley Forge General Hospital conducted extensive psychiatric work during the war. They might be able to give us the names of doctors who were on their staff at that time, and might be available.
