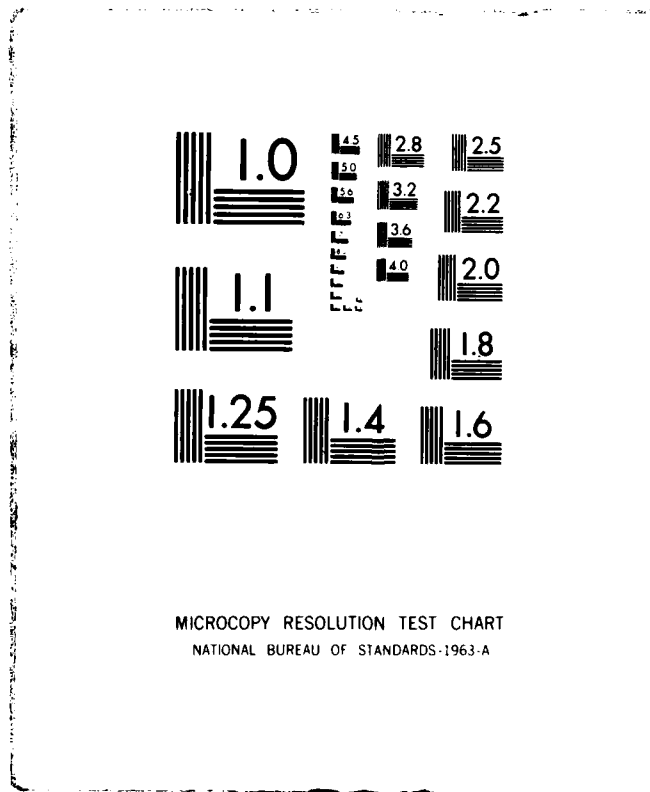

**Fiscal Year 1976**

Department of Defense Prime Contracts totaling \$728 million were awarded to 344 Educational and Other Nonprofit Institutions during fiscal year 1976, for Research, Development, Test and Evaluation Work. Of this total, \$697 million was awarded to 290 Nonprofit Institutions in the United States, \$15 million to 11 U.S. Government Agencies, and \$16 million to 43 Foreign Institutions and Government Agencies. These figures compare with similar data for fiscal year 1975, as follows:

There are three sections to this report. The first section lists 182 Educational and 108 Other Nonprofit Institutions in the U.S. The second section lists the 11 U.S. Government Agencies, and the third section lists the 43 Foreign Institutions and Government Agencies.

The locations shown are those where the work was expected to be performed. Generally, the location is an institution's laboratory or other facility. However, if the work was scheduled to be performed at a Defense activity, such as an Air Force Base, the location is the Defense activity rather than the institution's facility. The dollar amounts shown include only contract awards for RDT&E work. They exclude any other services, such as training services, or any supplies furnished by these contractors.
