HUMAN ENDURANCE

Scientists can easily determine the maximum output and endurance of a given machine within milimeters and micro-seconds, but they have never been able to measure or anticipate the extent of human endurance. As long as records stand, records will fall, because man's achievements can be measured only in the intangible terms of ambition, perseverance and physical health...MOW IS YOURS?



In 1924, a six-day endurance contest was held in London between George Hall, a marathon runner, and a race horse named Black Jack. On the fifth day the horse was withdrawn from the contest with Hall fifteen miles ahead and still going strong!

MISTER SURE SHOT. For six days and nights W. F. Carver fired at wooden balls which assistants tossed into the air in front of him. In 144 hours of continuous shooting, Carver made 58,819 hits, an average of 400 an hour.

THE SKIPPING TOURIST. For twenty-eight successive days Tom Morris skipped rope along the public highways of Australia. He covered 590 miles with 472,000 hops, averaging six and a half feet to a jump!

On August 27, 1889, at an army post in Jubbulpore, India, a tug of war was held between two military units, Company H and Company E. It took two hours and forty-one minutes for Company H to drag it s rivals the six in ches across the line.

WORLD TOURIST. Dr. Frances Nacci, Italian newspaperman, drave a midget automobile completely around the world in little mare than a year in 1952. In 50,000 miles of riding he had only three flat tires.



Andy Bowen and Jack Burke fought each other in a prize ring for seven hours and nineteen minutes in New Orleans - April 6, 1893. The referee stopped the contest in the 110th round and called it a draw when they became too exhausted to continue.



Pushing a wheelbarrow containing her belongings, and accompanied by her nine-year old son, Julia St. Clair walked across the United States from Jacksonville to Los Angeles. Mrs. St. Clair was fifty-nine years of age when she accomplished the 3,000-mile walk.

BURIED ALIVE. Ben Amalfo, an Austrian, remained in a burial crypt four feet underground for 250 hours to establish a world's record. During his internment he consumed only three eights of a guart of tea. Amalfo lost ten per cent of hs body weight as a result.

At Sunset Fields, Los Angeles, in 1933, Bob Swanson, a marathon golfer, played 306 holes in nineteen hours. During this time he walked seventy-six miles and took 1,474 strokes.

MUSICAL STAMINA. On June 17, 1952, Heinz Arntz played a piano continuously for 224 hours in Dusseldorf, Germany. Thus he topped his own previous record by one hour.

LONE RIDER. To announce the death of Queen Elizabeth, Robert Cary travelled 400 miles on horseback from London to Edinburgh in less than three days. During the trip Cary rode a distance of 155 miles in a single day.

THE CHAMPION FOOTMAN. Captain Newton H. Chittenden walked from the Pacific Ocean diagonally across the United States to the Gulf of Mexico, a distance of 3,350 miles in 1888-9. In forty years of travel he covered a distance of more than 200,000 miles of which 25,000 were on foot.



Equipped only with a small jackhammer, a lantern and a hand truck, William H. Schmidt worked thirty-two years - 1906-1938, digging a 2,000 foot tunnel through a granite mountain to transport ore from a mine he had discovered in Kern County, California.

DEEP SEA GIANT. A whale shark thirty-eight feet long and weighing more than thirteen tons was harpooned by Charles Thompson off the Florida coast on June 1, 1912. It took forty-eight hours to land the huge sea beast, the largest ever taken.




