





During the War of 1812 British troops numbering 4,000 men under the command of General Ross, were dispatched to attack Washington, D.C. After landing near Bladensburg, Maryland, they attacked a weak American militia stationed there. As part of their ammunition the British used sky tockets, which sizzling and crackling, threw panic into the American forces, which fled in wild

disorder before the strange onslaught of this devilish new instrument of war. To prevent Yankee gunboats from falling into British hands, the few stationed in Chesapeake Bay were blown up by the Americans. A small detachment of sailors from the gunboats kept the panic-stricken American militia from being completely destroyed. The British meanwhile had marched into our capital city, burning many of the public buildings.

Perhaps the most appalling of marine disasters was NIGHTMARE AT SEA. the wreck, in 1816, of a French frigate on Arguin Bank, sixty miles off the African coast. Of a complement of more than four hundred, 147 were put on a raft submerged two feet or more below the water. Conditions soon became indescribable. Some of the men, drunk from casks of wine brought along, fought each other like wildbeasts. The wounded and dying were thrown overboard. Many were driven mad. After thirteen days adrift at sea, only fifteen half-crazed curvivors were picked up by another French ship.

The panic caused in the United States in 1938 by a radio broadcast in which men from Mars landed in New Jersey to destroy the earth, is comparable to another such panic which arose in England in 1926. A radio dramatization was presented depicting a mob of unemployed people in the act of leveling London to the ground. Although several announcements were made that the play was a fanta



nouncements were made that the play was a fantasy, thousands of Britons telephoned newspapers and government officials asking for more information. They were all convinced that it was an actual newscast because of the realistic sound effect of bombs exploding and buildings falling to the ground.

CHURCH CONFLAGRATION. On December 8, 1863, a special service to commemorate a religious festival was held in the Church of La Compania in Santiago, Chile. A congregation of nearly 3,000 worshipers gathered within the confines of the church, which was gaily decorated with thousands of yards of muslin, and illuminated by two thousand candles and 20,000 oil lamps. Shortly before the high mass began pieces of the muslin became ignited by candle flame. Within a few minutes the entire church became a blazing inferno. Terror-stricken people fell over each other in a frantic dash for the doors which soon were blocked with tightly wedged bodies, preventing others from escaping the deadly flames, and blazing oil sprinkling down from overhead lamps. Approximately 2,500 people perished in the fire or died from injuries they received.

THE MYSTERIOUS EXPLOSION. A bomb that had a strange history was thrown in Haymarket Square, Chicago, during an outdoor labor meeting on the night of May 4, 1886. The incident set off a riot in which some twenty policemen and workers were killed and 250 others were injured. The identity of the man who threw the bomb was never learned. This case was the first in the United States in which dynamite was used as a weapon of death.

During the 1850's, many concerts presented in America were accompanied by tricks, stunts, and other circuslike features. A French conductor who specialized in such effects once gave a concert that none of his audience

ever forgot. On the night of June 15, 1854 he directed his orchestra in a unique arrangement of the Fireman's Quadrille at the Crystal Palace in New York. As the piece approached its climax the startled audience suddenly heard the clang of fire engine bells nearby. Windows crashed and flames burst through the roof. Firemen rushed in and turned on their hoses. The conductor more than accomplished his purpose of adding realism to the music. Dozens of people in the audience fainted while the rest of them ran for the exits in a mad state of confusion. Incidentally the realistic French conductor subsequently became insane and died in 1860.




